Laying the foundation

Construction in Uganda, Africa, as in most third world countries in general, is very different from construction practices we are familiar with here in the USA. Everything is done with hand labor. The stone for the foundation is delivered in very large pieces and has to be broken into the correct sizes needed, hammering it by hand.

The bricks they use are not of uniform size that we are accustomed to seeing. They are made in molds by hand, then stacked in very large hive-looking structures, with areas designed into them for fires to be built, to harden the bricks.

As the photo shows the delivery methods are also unique. No nice square pallet loads delivered by flat bed truck and forklift.

Our next newsletter will show how the bricks are laid for the buildings. Again, the methods used will be unfamiliar but the final product will be sturdy and safe. Can you imagine the beauty they see when compared to a building of mud bricks that deteriorate with each heavy rain?
