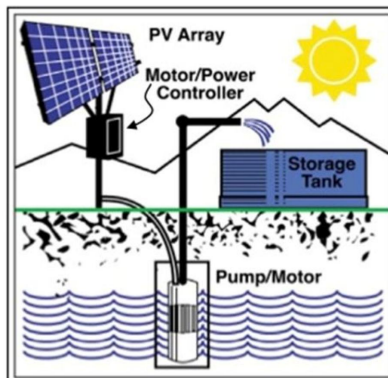

We are so incredibly grateful to the Lord for each of you who have given in support of the *Solar Water Pump Project*. We are thrilled and Praise God to be able to report to you this project is now fully funded!!!!!!!!!!



See the concept drawing below. All arrangements have been made for the construction and installation of the solar pump and associated equipment. Praise God from Whom all blessings flow!

Ken had secured *flight reservations* to be in Uganda during this project. The “hiccough”, as of this writing, is that the airspace over Doha, Qatar has been closed to civilian air traffic due to the Middle East conflict with Iran. We have witnessed that the prayers of the righteous move the heart of God! Ken spent all of

yesterday rearranging his flight schedule and airline carrier. We are blessed to report he has reservations to depart as planned on May 12th. and return to the states on May 30th. All Glory to God!!

We also ask that you would pray for an *end to this Iran conflict*. Not simply for our convenience of flight schedule but especially for the safety of innocent people in those areas and for our military men and women that are in harms way.

We have been hard at work with paperwork. We are now incorporated in the state of Florida as a charitable non-profit and been issued our EIN tax identification number. A bank account has been opened for Emmaus Gospel Outreach, Inc that will ensure all checks sent to us and written out to Emmaus Gospel Outreach, Inc will have a much quicker turn around in processing. Thanks be to God.

We are in the *process of obtaining our own 501 (C)(3) IRS tax exempt status*. This should greatly reduce the confusion when trying to financially partner with EmmausGO. The IRS application has been submitted and we now wait to hear from them. We have been told this could be lengthy and possibly declined pending more information. Please pray we will be patient, persistent and will find favor with the Lord and powers that be in this regard.
